<i>Colour</i>	Green-tinged
<i>Nose</i>	This wine teases the nose with flavours of green capsicum, freshly cut grass and hints of gooseberry.
<i>Palate</i>	These flavours follow through onto a juicy full palate with a clean mineral aftertaste.
<i>Ageing potential</i>	Enjoy now to end 2020
<i>Appreciation</i>	Serve well-chilled
<i>Food pairing</i>	Enjoy with fresh fish, pastas, white meats and salads

<i>Blend</i>	100% Sauvignon Blanc
<i>Origin</i>	Wine of Origin Robertson Zandvliet Estate, established 1867 / 50ha
<i>Analysis</i>	Alc / Vol 12.80 % Acidity 6.2 g/ℓ pH 3.25 Residual sugar 3.0 g/ℓ
<i>Maturation</i>	Unoaked
<i>Terroir</i>	Slope Very gently, southerly Soil Rocky, chalk rich Climate Moderate summers with low night temperatures; cold winters Wind Cool south-easterly in summer
<i>Yield</i>	8 -10 ton/ha
<i>Oenology</i>	Grapes are harvested when fully ripened in early morning, then crushed, de-stemmed and cold-soaked on skins for about 8 hrs. Juice drawn off, settled & fermented.
